

Part II: Financial Information

Program Dates: July 1 - August 10

Students requesting an I-20 must register and enroll as full-time students. Full-time enrollment is defined as registration for a minimum of 6 credits in one summer session. All international students participating in the GW Pre-College Program are required to enroll in two 3 credit hour courses. These expenses are estimates based on 2016 tuition. Actual program charges will be updated on the GW Pre-College Program website.

SOURCE OF FUNDS

According to U.S. federal regulations, prior to issuance of an I-20 or DS-2019, The George Washington University is required to obtain certification that students have financial resources adequate to provide for their expenses without resorting to unauthorized employment. All documents must be written in English or accompanied by a certified translation. Original bank statements must indicate sufficient funds in cash for living expenses, tuition & fees, and related costs of study. Documents must be dated within 12 months of the program start date at the time of submission.

Self-Support 1) Original or a copy of a dated bank letter on official letterhead indicating your name as \$ the account holder, the date the account was opened and the present balance.	
OR	
Parents or Sponsors 1) A letter of support from a parent or sponsor who intends to provide for your living and \$ academic expenses. The letter must indicate in numeric figures the amount of funds to be provided, the duration of the support, and the relative's relationship to you (e.g. father) AND 2) Original or a copy of a dated letter from the parent or sponsor's bank stating the name of the account holder, date the account was opened and the present balance.
