### DOCUMENTATION COVERING ADDITIONAL EXPENSES

**Family Expenses:** If you are married and plan to bring your spouse and/or children, you must also certify at least U.S. \$2,699 for your spouse and U.S. \$1,350 for each child. Please note that on-campus housing is not available for families.

**Employment Prohibitions:** In computing your expenses, you should bear in mind that students holding exchange visitor (J) visas will not be authorized to work. Therefore, **you should not anticipate employment**, either part-time during the academic year or full-time during the summer, as a means of support while in the United States. It is not recommended for students with F-visas to find employment during the compressed summer semester.
